#### Notes on Fees

- Fees for 2023 will remain the same as in 2022. All students must pay the Compulsory Fees, online, comprising the tuition fee, service fee, administrative fee, and SRC fee.
- New Students**
  - Compulsory Fees payable by Postgraduate Students and International Students, including Undergraduate and Postgraduate South Pacific Students and dependents of UPNG Expatriate Staff do not include residential, service, administrative, or SRC fees, which were to be paid as additional fees, but were never paid. Hence, all such students will pay K533.00 in addition to their annual tuition fees.
  - All new students who have been selected to study at UPNG will receive a Letter of Offer and an Invoice prior to Friday 3 February 2023.
  - New students must pay the Compulsory Fees, online, in full, by Friday 3 February 2023 to avoid the automatic withdrawal of your offer and place at the University.
  - Online and blended learning is now a University requirement, so all new students who have been selected to study at UPNG must bring his or her own laptop.
- New and Continuing Students**
  - Fees payable by students on TESAS Scholarships may be adjusted, based on the level of subsidy specified by the Department of Higher Education, Research, Science, and Technology (DHERST), under TESAS. Students are required to pay the compulsory fees, online, in order to register.
  - Please note that accommodation on campus is not guaranteed. The allocation of available rooms in the halls of residence is subject to full payment of the compulsory fees, plus 50% of the Board & Lodging fees by Friday 10 February 2023.
  - If you require accommodation on campus, on your arrival, please pay in full the compulsory fees, plus 50% of the prescribed accommodation fees, as advised, prior to taking occupancy of your room.
  - The refundable Security Bond fee of K250.00 must be paid by all first-time residential students before occupying their allocated rooms.
- Continuing Students**
  - All Continuing students are advised to email [feequeries@upng.ac.pg](mailto:feequeries@upng.ac.pg) or call **3267321/3267604/3267249**. The Proforma Invoice is for the full payment of the Compulsory Fees, online, by Friday 3 February 2023. No lesser/excess fee payment will be accepted by the system for online registration starting in 2023. Any queries concerning your Proforma Invoice please email [feequeries@upng.ac.pg](mailto:feequeries@upng.ac.pg) or call **3267321/3267604/3267249**.
  - Any continuing students who fail to meet the minimum GPA requirements for progression into the next year of his or her studies **MUST NOT RETURN** to the University in 2023. If you are unsure of your status, please check the UPNG Website [www.upng.ac.pg](http://www.upng.ac.pg), or contact the Academic & Student Administration **immediately**.
  - Students are fully responsible for the payment of outstanding fees that have not been paid by their respective sponsors from previous years, including 2022.
  - Student debtors will only be allowed to register, if all outstanding debts accumulated up to, and including 2022, plus the Compulsory Fees for 2023 are paid **IN FULL** by Friday 3 February 2023. Otherwise, **DO NOT RETURN** to the University.
  - No Letter of Guarantee will be accepted as a requirement for students to register. All compulsory fees must be paid, online, in full, by the required deadlines in order to register.
- Payments**
  - All fees of undergraduate programs delivered through the internal mode of delivery must be paid online on the University Information System (UIS) using the BSP Pay platform.** The guidelines for information on how to pay the compulsory fees online can be accessed from the UPNG Website [www.upng.ac.pg](http://www.upng.ac.pg). Read the manual and understand the steps before attempting to pay the compulsory fees online.
  - The University will not accept any cash payment for Compulsory Fees into the Tuition Fee Account, except for the board and lodging fee and for those studying through distance mode of delivery. The online platform for payment of Compulsory Fees using BSP Pay will be available by Monday, 23 January 2023.
